Dear Parents,

Following tonight's Government announcement, I am extremely sad to say that we are left with no choice but to close the physical doors of the School with immediate effect and switch to our remote learning program for all pupils in Reception and above. Our understanding is that our Pre-Nursery and Nursery Provision remains unaffected at this time and is accessible to all families tomorrow.

Building on the success of Seesaw last term, we have been working hard to diversify our remote learning provision for children in Reception to Year 6 in the event of a bubble collapse or whole school lockdown due to Covid-19. Whilst Seesaw remains our primary platform for the posting and submission of work, live daily teaching will now be included in our English and maths provision using Zoom video conferencing technology. ### Brontë House Remote Learning | Woodhouse Grove School

In line with Government guidance, we will provide on-site learning provision for Vulnerable Children and the Children of Critical Workers from tomorrow morning, Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January.

The provision will be in a supervised environment where children falling into the categories of vulnerable or whose parents are Critical Workers will join their peers, who remain at home, in completing the remote learning programme.

School will be open from 08:00am and all pupils should be collected by 4:30pm. A light lunch will be provided. Children should attend in school PE kit and with a school coat.

We would ask that parents of pupils who are considering making use of the on-site provision, refer to this link prior to completing the survey below, to ensure we are doing all we can to safely and effectively manage the numbers in school.



Schools have received no prior warning of tonight's announcement. All staff will be in school tomorrow, planning for a full rollout of the remote learning program on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> January.

The platforms will not be manned by class teachers as they will be either in meetings or adapting their lesson materials to make them suitable for Zoom and Seesaw. From the following day, Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> January, we will go 'live' with a full complement of remote learning provision.
