Please find the relevant information below for the summer holidays in Ashdown Early Years' Provision. The Early Years' provision will run from Monday 12th July until Wednesday 1st September. (Please note that we are closed on Thursday 2nd and Friday 3rd September for staff training). Parents whose children are on a 51 week contract or a Term time + 8 weeks contract have already been allocated a space and need not take any further action from this letter.

We have some additional places available. If you would like to book your child in for the summer holidays on an adhoc basis, this will be at an extra cost of £55 per day. Please email Miss Hargreaves on hargreaves.septontehouse.co.uk if you are interested.

Please note that children are still unable to mix between Bubbles and so places are limited. Applying for a space does not guarantee a place in Holiday Early Year's provision, but we will do our best to accommodate as many families as possible in a safe environment.

The children will receive a hot lunch and a light tea of sandwiches and crudites that will be served at 4:30pm each afternoon.


