Dear Parents,

Half term is upon us already; the first 6 weeks of the new year have flown by! We have slowly made our way back to a more normal school routine, with the re-introduction of specialist teaching, sports fixtures and a full programme of co-curricular opportunities. Judging by the numbers attending after-school activities each week, the children are thoroughly enjoying the breadth of opportunities available.

Whilst we have kept Covid at bay for the majority of the first half of term, the last few days have proven challenging, with a marked increase in cases, and one Year Group returning to the bubble precautions of the previous year. Speaking to other Junior School Heads, this increase appears to be a trend reflected in many other schools, who are also reporting a swell in Covid cases in Primary-aged children. Please be assured that parents will always be informed if Covid cases in a particular section of the school rise above accepted levels and we will take no hesitation in increasing our control measures to ensure that our children and staff remain safe. The half-term break will afford an opportunity to break chains of transmission within school and start the second part of the term afresh.

We would ask for your continued support in collecting children from school who present as symptomatic and following NHS testing guidance. Whilst we appreciate that this may not be convenient, it is vital in ensuring that Covid cases are kept to a minimum. It is also imperative that the School Office is made aware of test results before children are returned to school.

All children in Years 1-6 should attend school in PE kits and tracksuit.


Refreshments available on the sports field for a small donation to the ABA.
