Practitioners and/or Theatre Companies to your own work/to extracts from play texts set by the exam
board.
Task 1.b, Using what you found out about the performance styles of the Theatre Practitioners listed
above, choose TWO, and re-write 2 pages from a play you know well in this new style. You may also
swap the genders of characters, change some of the character's lines, twist the story/plot, delete some
lines, add new stage directions and even change the location!

<u>During the first term</u>, you will begin to read and study 2 set texts, **The Trojan Women by Euripides** and **Accidental Death of an Anarchist by Dario Fo.**

Task 2: Use Google to find a plot summary for both these plays

Task 3: Research how an original production of both these plays might have looked. (see 3a & 3b)

<u>Task 3a:</u> *The Trojan Women* is a piece of Ancient Greek Theatre, find out about how a performance was staged in an Amphitheatre. Find a contemporary version of this play and find a theatre review of it.

<u>Task 3b</u>: *An Accidental Death of an Anarchist* how was it originally staged/where was it first performed? Find a theatre review of the original production or a recent production of it.

<u>Task 5:</u> At A-level, you may choose to be assessed as a performer or as a designer. In the exams, you will need to be able to analyse and evaluate performances based on a wide range of drama skills. <u>Watch a play over the summer (either at the theatre or online) and make a mind map of the design elements you thought helped to generate meaning. This should include: lighting, sound, costume, staging and set design.</u>
