# Subject Specification AQA A-level Geography

#### **Component 1 - Physical Geography**

40% of the total A-level mark—2½ hours

20% of total A-level mark


Students complete an individual investigation which must include data collected in the field. The individual investigation must be based on a question or issue defined and developed by the student relating to any part of the specification content.
