## Location

Located in the scenic Yorkshire countryside, yet just a 10-minute train ride from Leeds city centre. Perfect for those seeking the best of both worlds - enjoying areas of natural and cultural beauty while remaining close to shops, restaurants, and vibrant city life.

# What to Expect...

**Woodhouse Grove's immersion programme is a gateway to British boarding life.**

Students join regular classes studying maths, science, humanities, the arts and sport; and engage in co-curricular activities and weekend excursions - all while being fully integrated into our warm and inclusive school community.

Students also have the opportunity to develop their English skills with tailored support provided by our ESOL-qualified teachers.

Weekends follow a much more relaxed timetable to allow free time, along with excursions.

Saturdays are lively at the school, with a full schedule of sports fixtures attracting day pupils and visiting schools. Breakfast is enjoyed in-house, followed by lunch at 12:30 pm, tea is served at 5:30 pm - perfect for refuelling between activities.

On Sundays, boarders have brunch at 11am and tea at 5pm in the dining hall.





# Facilities

- Extensive 70-acre private estate in Yorkshire.

  - Brodwell House (boys) twin rooms with ensuite bathroom;
  - Miller House (girls) traditional twin or individual rooms with shared facilities;
  - Brodwell Annexe self-contained boarding suite (x10 twin rooms + staff).
- 25m competition swimming pool.
- 240 seat theatre, drama studio & music rooms.
- Fitness suite and climbing wall.
- Outdoor covered courts complex.
- Traditional dining hall providing a wide choice of healthy & nutritious meals.
- Apperley Bridge train station - 5 mins on foot (Leeds 9 minutes).
- Local shops and supermarket within a short walk.

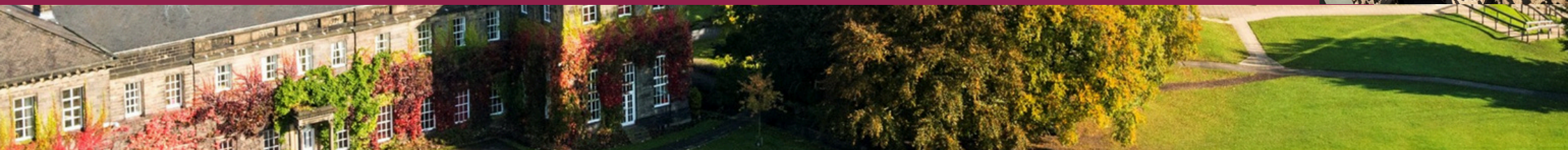
