Woodhouse Grove School Covid-19 (Coronavirus) Visitor Statement

Before entering/signing into the school:

In response to the global coronavirus outbreak, Woodhouse Grove School has implemented a strict visitor policy to safeguard the health and wellbeing of the whole school community.

As set out in the Government guidelines we ask you not to enter the school today, if you have COVID-19-like symptoms, however mild – either a new continuous cough or a high temperature.

Or if you have:

- Visited, or transited through, any of the high-risk countries or territories listed below* within the past seven days.
- Come into direct contact with anyone who has visited, or transited through, any of the high-risk countries or territories listed below* within the past seven days.

Should you fulfil any of the criteria listed above, your visit to the school should be rearranged as soon as the seven-day incubation period, outlined by the Government has elapsed, providing you are symptom free.

*High Risk Countries: China, Thailand, Japan, Republic of North Korea, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Singapore, Malaysia, Macau, Iran, Northern Italy.
